Introduction To The Gospel Of John:

The Apostle John is the author of The Gospel of John. He is also the author of 1, 2 and 3rd John. The purpose of the Gospel was to record Jesus' "signs" so that the readers would come to believe on Him. While Luke represented Jesus as the Son of Man, John presents Jesus in His deity, the Son of God. John's entire Gospel, when studied in context, actually revolves around Jesus' seven "signs" and His seven" I Am" statements. Just like the other three Gospels, Matthew, Mark and Luke, the main focus of the book is the Good News of Jesus' death and resurrection.

Key verse: "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved." John 3. 16,17 NKJV
