Ezra, the priest, led Judahös second exiled group is return to Jerusalem. He addressed the group when he saw signs that they were falling into the same path that their forefathers had fallen into. Some m en in the group had m arried pagan wom en and had children who could potentially have been exposed to religions which were against God. Though recorded in the New Testam ent, God had dem anded in the 0 H Testam ent, & gre not unequally yoked togetherw ith unbelievers 2 Corinthians 6:14

Then the person and his fam ily would be ex-com municated from the com munity. Ezra had made a tough decision; how ever, his decision was based on Godös law for Godös people. God requires that H is children make tough decisions. How ever, He is the One we live to honor.
