EPHESUS

Revelation 2.1-7

BACKGROUND:

At the time of this writing the church at Ephesus had a population of nearly a quarter of a million people. It was considered the commercial center of Asia Minor. The temple of Artemis, located in Ephesus, was one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. The apostle Paul had done some of his most successful Christian work in Ephesus. So many people were converted to Christ that almost overnight the church became one of the greatest influences in city, and soon became one of the most famous churches in the world. It became known as the mother church of Asia Minor. (Halley's Bible Handbook)
