- In Christ we have redemption
- 6. What does Hebrew 10:12 say about Christ's sacrifice?
- Christ's sacrifice is complete
- 7. Read Hebrews 10:17. Why is it foolish for you to continue to feel guilty about sin?
- God no longer remembers our sin
- 8. According to Ephesians 4:32, what should be your attitude toward those who have offended you? Why?
- Our attitude should be one of kindness, compassion, understanding, forgiveness, just as Christ forgave you
