# Faith of a Canaanite <br> Matthew 15:21-28 <br> Devotional Reading: Psalm 61 <br> Background Scripture: Matthew 15:21-28 

LESSON AIMS: the students will:

- SUMMARIZE the interaction between Jesus and the Canaanite woman
- EXPLAIN Jesus' response in verse 24
- BRAINSTORM the situations where a parent should and should not intervene on behalf of a child

INTRODUCTION: Tyre and Sidon were Gentile cities, located some 50 miles away. Jesus went all this way to meet this one Gentile woman's need. This shows remarkable and unexpected love from Jesus to this woman of Canaan. The relationship between Jews and Canaanites in the Roman world was generally strained. It was not the norm for a Canaanite woman to approach a Jewish man under any circumstances. Though aware of the culture of the time, this woman took a bold step. She must have been aware of the Lord, whom she addressed as "Son of David."

KEY VERSE ${ }^{28}$ Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.
