Devotional Reading: Psalm 118:15 - 29 Background Scripture: Revelation 5

LESSON AIMS: the students will:

- **Identify** the Lion, the Root, and the Lamb
- Explain the significance of each of those three designations
- Participate with classmates in writing lyrics for a new song of praise

INTRODUCTION: In this passage, John's visions move from God the Creator to Jesus the Redeemer. Jesus will come in view when we see the final judgment of the world taking place. Jesus is called the Lion because Jesus will be the Judge. More important, He is called the Lamb because Jesus is also the Savior of the world.

KEY VERSE: ⁹ And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;

Summary: In their new song, the people acclaimed the Lamb as worthy to execute judgment because of His redemptive work on the Cross. Beyond redemption, the Lord has made believers kings and priests to worship Him, to witness for Him and to reign with Him over the millennial earth.
