## The Servant's Suffering Isaiah 53:1 - 7

Devotional Reading: Matthew 12:14 - 21 Background Scripture: Isaiah 52:13 - 53:12

## **LESSON AIMS:** the students will:

**LESSON OUTLINE:** 

- **Identify** the suffering Servant
- **Relate** the Servant's suffering to the concept of substitutionary atonement
- Write a prayer of gratitude for what the servant's suffering accomplished

**INTRODUCTION:** Isaiah 53 foretells the sufferings of the Messiah, the purpose of His death and the benefits of His remarkable life. It focuses on Christ's suffering and death and details what He endured for us. The Servant, who did not need to atone for sin, offered His life for disobedient mankind. God allows Israel's [and mankind's] waywardness to fall upon the shoulders of His sinless Son. The suffering Servant's humility is a key point which is brought out in this text.

**KEY VERSE:** <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53:6

# Servant's Appearance Isiah 53:1 - 3 Servant's Suffering verses 4 - 7

**Summary:** Isaiah 53 describes the death of the Suffering Servant. In all that He endured as He walked the earth, encountering relentless criticism and lies, Christ never sinned. God transformed and baptized those who had not only been enemies of God but also scorned Him as He tried to improve their lives. Humanity often scorns humility, but God values this trait [see Psalm 138:6; Isaiah 57:15; James 4:6]. The Suffering Servant brought peace and healing. As God's representatives, we are called to agents of peace [Romans 14:19] striving to reconcile relationships, heal divisions, even when this requires sacrifice from us.
